



THE PEOPLE HAVE SPOKEN !

Residents in our suburb congregated at the Church Hall in Rabie Street on 23 February. The purpose of the meeting was to provide all the background facts and suggested solutions to settle the outstanding debt to Piranha.

The outcome of the meeting was as follows:

An overwhelming majority of residents present voted in favour of paying a once off levy and accepting a future monthly contribution increase that would be dependent on how many residents join the RRA and convert to Piranha in the next month.

The RRA will act on the instructions stated in the ballot forms that were either presented at the special meeting or sent via electronic mail. It will be assumed that those RRA residents that have not completed their ballot forms are in agreement with the majority that voted at the special meeting and will have the levy added to their existing debit order in 2 equal installments in the months of March and April.

A big **thank you** goes out to those residents that attended the special meeting and aired their views.

The RRA committee has taken note of all stated and mailed suggestions to increase the membership within our suburb and develop a sense of community.

On a final note, please urge any non paying neighbours in your vicinity to join the RRA. They are benefiting at our expense.

HOW TO CONVERT TO PIRANHA

The resident needs to establish the notice period in the contract with their current security provider. Once this has been established the resident will give notice and complete a debit form (available from the **Cat Box** in Maria Street, or from the website - www.rra.za.org/how.php or kmoulton@telkomsa.net).

Once completed, please either drop it off at the Cat Box or fax to 088-011-791-5056. If you prefer you can email to neilgove@tiscali.co.za.

The RRA will alert Piranha, who will make the necessary arrangements with the resident to remove the existing transmitter and replace it with their own. This will cost the resident a once off fee of R228 inclusive of VAT.

All alarm systems currently linked to an armed response company can be fitted with the Piranha transmitter in a quick and painless manner.

We look forward to many conversions as we strive to maintain the security in our neighbourhood.
